THE CHALLENGES OF A BINATIONAL SOCIETY

- 3** Mission-S, the programme aimed at reducing accidents in the construction sites
- 16** First case of binational application of anti-mafia and anti-corruption regulations
- 9** "Patto per il Territorio" and "Demarche Grand Chantier" initiatives to maximise the positive impact of construction sites in their host territories
- 13** Environmental monitoring of dust, noise, water, radiation and climate in the areas around the construction sites

The Lyon-Turin line is a freight and passenger new railway line that covers **270 km**, of which **57.5** consist of the twin-tube base tunnel at the ends of which are the international alpine stations of Susa and Saint-Jean-de-Maurienne

The line is the central link of the **TEN-T Mediterranean corridor**, which connects the continent from east to west

THE LYON-TURIN PROJECT ROADMAP

From the European challenge to the binational agreements

- 1992** The Commission of EC issues the white paper: *The Future Development of the Common Transport Policy*
- 1996** Italy and France establish an Intergovernmental Commission (CIG) to implement the Lyon-Turin treaties
- 2001** **TURIN SUMMIT** First international agreement for the construction of the new line. The EU co-finances 50% studies and geognostic work
- 2012** **LYON AND ROME SUMMITS** Second agreement on the project: guarantee of commitment by the two countries
- 2015** **PARIS SUMMIT** Agreement on the start of the final works and first agreement with the EU



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
